

## **Make a Gift**

Contributions to the endowment accounts or scholarship funds (see list below) allow students to borrow less or work fewer hours which, in turn, enables them to spend more uninterrupted time on their studies or in volunteer activities. Instead of working to accumulate tuition expenses, some of our social work students have devoted their vacation periods to helping others (e.g. in orphanages in Romania, building schools in Central America or Africa, or distributing emergency supplies and helping rebuild communities in the United States).

### **A. Scholarship Funds**

Scholarships are available for social work majors once they are admitted to advanced standing. Students apply spring semester of their junior year. Applications are typically due mid-March. The scholarships are awarded near the end of spring semester and will be applied the following fall of their senior year.

- Evelyn Hodges and Theodore R.E. Lewis Scholarship
  - Social work GPA and University overall GPA of 3.0
  - Shows promise for success in the Social Work Program
- Frances Handwerker Memorial Scholarship
  - This scholarship was established by her daughter, Terry Peak, and is awarded on the basis of a combination of merit, need, and topical interest (aging/women's studies)
- LuAnn M. Hamilton Memorial Scholarship
  - Requirements are scholarship, initiative, character and Professional promise
- Social Work Trust Scholarship
  - Awarded to a female
  - Based on financial need
- The Terry and David Peak Scholarship
  - Applicants for this scholarship (for MSW students only) will be selected based on merit and demonstrated commitment to the values of the discipline of Social Work.

## **B. Social Work Development account**

Money donated to this account is used in support of our local volunteer activities (e.g. to purchase landscaping materials for Common Ground and the Child & Family Support Center or supplies for holiday food baskets) or to help fund conference travel expenses for social work students. Donors may desire to designate a specific purpose for their donations.
